Social Security 2021

Social Security and Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits will increase 1.3% percent in 2021. The 1.3% percent cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) will begin with benefits payable to Social Security beneficiaries in January 2021. Increased payments to more than 8 million SSI beneficiaries will begin on December 31, 2020. (Note: some people receive both Social Security and SSI benefits.)

Any of your family or friends could be infected with COVID and still show zero signs of the illness. If you find out you have been exposed to COVID or if you become ill, you will have to quarantine. Reminder

The doors are locked for the safety of our residents. Please do not open the doors and allow people to enter the facility without a staff member. They need to call the front desk prior to entering where they will then be screened for symptoms of COVID. We have a phone and clearly marked instructions at the front entrance.

All caregivers and/or family members entering after hours must make alternate arrangements with the office prior to entering. Due to the severity of the pandemic, any violation of this rule will be considered a substantial lease violation.

November 2020 Service Coordinator Resource Connection

Help fight Medicare fraud! Review your Medicare Summary Notices for errors and report anything suspicious to Medicare.

- Compare the dates and services on your calendar with the statements you get from Medicare to make sure you received each service listed and that all the details are correct.
- Check your claims early—the sooner you see and report errors, the sooner you can help stop fraud.
- Check the receipts and statements you get from providers for mistakes.

If you think a charge is incorrect and you know the provider, you may want to call their office to ask about it. The person you speak to may help you better understand the services or supplies you received, or they may realize a billing error was made.

If you've contacted the provider and you suspect that Medicare is being charged for health care you didn't get, or you don't know the provider on the claim, please report this information to Medicare. You can report suspected Medicare fraud calling 1-800-MEDICARE (1-800-633-4227).

Have this information ready before you report fraud:

- Your name and Medicare Number.
- The provider's name and any identifying information you may have.
- The service or item you're questioning and when it was supposedly given or delivered.
- The payment amount approved and paid for by Medicare.
- The date on your Medicare Summary Notice or claim.
